

The 17th e-Portfolio Student Learning Journey Competition

一、Objective of the Event:

The e-Portfolio Student Learning Journey Competition aims to systematically record students' academic experiences and achievements. This comprehensive e-Portfolio serves immediate purposes like scholarship applications and part-time work, as well as long-term benefits in preparing students for further education and employment. The competition encourages mutual learning among students, and combined with resume optimization courses, strives to enhance the quality and quantity of e-Portfolio content for academic and professional success.

二、Participants and Registration Instructions:

- Starting now, each four-year technical program class advisor should nominate 5 or more students. Participants must achieve an 80% e-portfolio completion rate by March 28 (Tuesday), or they lose eligibility. Submit the participant list via email or hard copy to Ms. Lin through the class representative at the library.
- Registration Period: From March 1, 2024 (Friday) to March 13, 2024 (Wednesday).

三、Competition Rules:

- Competition Briefing:** It will take place on March 14 (Thursday) from 6:00 PM to 6:30 PM at the open lecture area on the Fourth floor of the Library and Information Building.
- Preliminary Stage: Preliminaries**
 - Participants:** Freshmen, sophomores, and seniors (5 students per class minimum; juniors can join freely).
 - Date:** March 27 (Tuesday) from 9:00 AM to 11:00 AM
 - Rules:** Create e-portfolios from registration until March 26. On March 27, the system administrator will verify if completion rates are 80% or above. Those meeting this criterion advance to the finals.

- Final Stage: Finals**
 - Participants:** Those who passed preliminaries (Results announced on March 27).
 - Briefing:** March 28 (Thursday) from 6:00 PM to 6:30 PM at the open lecture area.
 - Date:** April 24 (Wednesday) from 1:30 PM to 3:30 PM.
 - Venue:** Computer Classroom, 1st floor, Library and Information Building.
 - Rules:** Finalists (March 28 to April 23) export e-portfolios as a "Word Resume" and create a unique personal resume. On the final day, judges evaluate resumes to determine winners.
 - Judges:** Two faculty members from each department (Total of 20 judges).
 - Evaluation Criteria:**

四、Award Scheme:

- April 25(Thursday) Announcement of winners.
- April26(Friday)-May3(Friday) Certificate and voucher collection period (non-redeemable after this period).
- Finals Incentive Voucher:** NT\$200 voucher for all students in the finals who submit their works.

五、Notes:

- The organizer may adjust the number of awardees (or declare vacancies) based on competition results, within the total scholarship amount limit.
- All participants must set e-portfolio viewing permissions to "Members Only" (excluding personal information). Failure to do so and impeding administrators from reviewing completion rates during the preliminary round will result in disqualification.
- In the event of a tie in the finals, the participant with the higher score in specific criteria will be ranked higher, following the order of "Personal Information" > "Part-Time Work and Extracurricular Activities" > "Works, Certificates, and Honors" > "Visual Aesthetics."
- Entries violating copyright or intellectual property rights will result in disqualification, and participants are liable for legal consequences.
- By participating, contestants grant the university the right to publicly display and use their submissions without notice for observation purposes.
- Winners must claim their awards within the specified period, or they will be considered forfeiting their prizes.
